
The new eddy current method from CARTEC Autotechnik Fuchs GmbH has a patent pending. It is used in a closed system, which is loaded with a special matting substrate. The swirl body, resembling a four-leaf clover in front of the conical nozzle junction, uses compressed air to generate a strongly expanding rotating action cone.

The rotational effect of the airflow guides the micro-fine matting tangentially over the alloy wheel. This creates a very finely machined flat painting surface and excludes any non-uniform grinding marks. The surface is matted to the finest detail and guarantees optimum mechanical adhesion for the new coat.

The improved paint adhesion also ensures significantly better corrosion protection.
